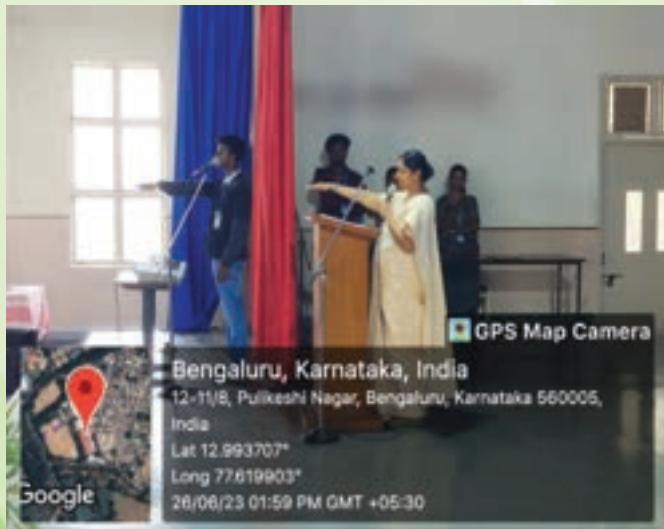

and Geeta Rameseshan, advocate and activist. Among the other accounts shared were those of at least five women who fell victim to the perils of a patriarchal society. Some were coerced by their fathers-in-law to quit their jobs, while others faced threats of severe consequences if they gave birth to a girl. Most of the survivors expressed their gratitude for reaching out for help instead of suffering in silence, which ultimately kept them alive.

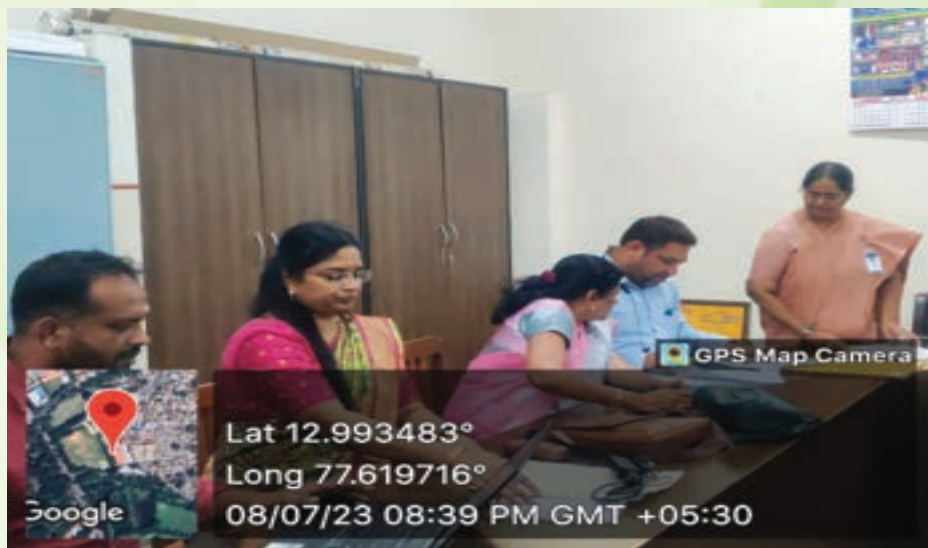
